Education for Disadvantaged	<b>\$227.4 MORE</b>	Schools in low income communities
Special Education	<b>\$445.6 LESS</b>	Includes special education preschool grants
<b>Vocational &amp; Adult Education</b>	<b>\$618.3 LESS</b>	Includes funding for vocational education, adult education, and English literacy.
<b>WIC</b>	<b>\$235.3 LESS</b>	Estimated 52,700 women, infants and children would lose benefits
<b>Child Care Development Block Grant</b>	<b>\$105.3 LESS</b>	Does not include mandatory and matching funds
<b>Children and Families Services</b>	<b>\$424.2 LESS</b>	Includes the Community Services Block Grant (CSBG), Head Start, and Services for Abused and Neglected Children
<i>Number of Children in Head Start</i>		<i>Between 7,000 and 9,000 <b>fewer</b> Head Start slots in 2011</i>
<b>Public Housing Capital Fund</b>	<b>\$97.2 LESS</b>	Supports modernization and other capital improvements in public housing developments
<b>Community Development Block Grant</b>	<b>\$378 LESS</b>	Supports community and economic development activities
<b>Social Services Block Grant</b>	<b>\$37.8 LESS</b>	Supports promotion of economic self-sufficiency, the prevention or remedy neglect, abuse or the exploitation of children and adults, and other programs.
